

## Our Childcare Room - The Rainbow Room: Basics for Parents

Welcome to our Childcare room! It is our goal at the Unitarian Universalist Church of Corpus Christi to provide a safe, comfortable and nurturing environment for your child. We also want you to feel secure about your child's well-being while you attend services and activities. Parents may stay with their children in the nursery to help them feel more comfortable in their new surroundings and of course, may drop in at any time.

Quick List!

- Children from infants up to and including age four are welcome.
- Children above the age of four are not allowed in the childcare room between 10:30 12:30 am on Sunday mornings.
- Caregivers will not accept children that are ill. Please do not bring your child if they have been ill within the past 24 hours.
- Caregivers will not give medication to children.
- If a scheduled caregiver is sick, we may call upon parents or other qualified adults to fill in.
- Essentials bags (diapers, sippy cups, clothing, etc.) need to be clearly labeled with the name of the parent or child. All of the items in the bag should also be clearly labeled with the name or initials of your child.
- Please leave toys and other personal items at home except those that are needed for comfort.
- Children will only be released to a properly identified and preauthorized adult.
- It is common for children to cry when you leave. Normally, the children will calm down in just a few minutes. If your child continues to be upset for 10 minutes (or sooner by parent's request) with no sign of calming down, a nursery volunteer will message you.
